SANITARY CERTIFICATE

(Issued under provisions of Public Health Act 1939 under sections (u/s 21, 33, 63, 64, 67, 98 & 106))


I hereby declare that I have inspected the school **SRI KUMARAN PUBLIC SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL(CBSE), NH-47, CHENGAPALLI, UTHUKULI (T.K) Tiruppur Dist. (S.F.No.12/1 TO 7 & 122)** building and premises on the day of **02.12.2024** and certify that

- a) The class room and surroundings are maintained neat and clean.
- b) The Sanitary arrangements provided are adequate and satisfactory.
- c) The drinking water arrangements provided is satisfactory.

This Certificate is issued subject to the following conditions:

1. The Garbage generated within the Premises should be collected and dispose properly by appointing required Sanitary Staff.
2. On any account the Garbage should not be burnt.
3. The children should be educated to prevent the usage of plastics in the school/Institution premises and no one should bring plastic carry bags, use and throw tumblers to the school/institution.
4. N.O.C should be obtained from the District Health Officer, to run a food establishment within premises.
5. Fire precaution measures and First Aid Box should be provided.
6. Child Labour should not be engaged in any account.
7. Every person in charge of place should be display and exhibit a board stating that the place is a **"No smoking and No spitting place"** and that: **Smoking or spitting is an offence** and **"Tobacco-free"** institution, sale or offer of cigarettes or other tobacco products is strictly prohibited in the area within a radius of 100 yards, which shall be both Tamil and English and the version in the second place below the Tamil version
8. This certificate issued is liable to be cancelled at any time on infringement if any of the above said conditions and for improper maintenance of sanitation, improper maintenance of the building as well as toilets in the Establishment.
9. Any outbreak of communicable diseases must be informed to health authorities concerned immediately.
10. **This Sanitary Certificate valid one year from the date of issue.**
